IX. Our Policy Regarding the Age of Potential Adopters

Adopting a cat is a lifetime commitment, so that the cat receives attention, care and respect for the rest of his life. We need to feel comfortable that each potential adopter

- can provide a stable environment for the cat,
- has the ability to pay for medical care, as well as basic necessities,
- will be in good enough health to care for the cat

For these reasons, we apply additional scrutiny to potential adopters who are less than 21 (twenty-one) years of age or older than 70 (seventy) years of age and **require that these persons provide below a "back up" caretaker or adopter for their newly adopted cat**. We treat each case individually and are happy to work with you to find a solution.

Potential Adopters Less than the Age of 21

A potential adopter who is at least 18 (eighteen) years of age¹, but less than 21 years of age, is less likely than an older person

- to have the financial means to care for a cat,
- to have a stable living situation to ensure that the cat will have an appropriate home for an extended period of time.

For these reasons, our Adoption Counselors may ask questions that seem intrusive.

Potential Adopters Older than the Age of 70

A potential adopter who is over 70 years of age, is less likely than a younger person

- to outlive a young cat,
- to remain healthy enough to provide a lifetime of care for a cat.

For these reasons, our Adoption Counselors will ask you to consider older cats and may ask intrusive questions.
